

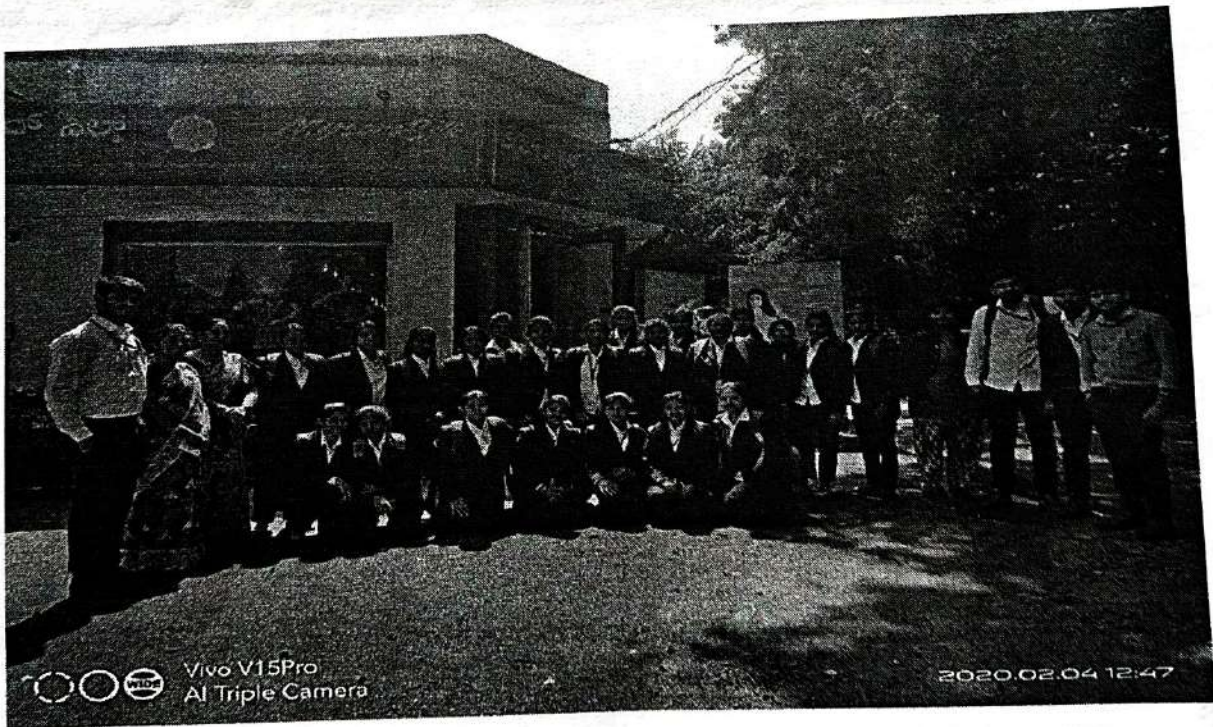

- get to deal with people from various social backgrounds, religions and cultures, which helps you learn to adopt a new culture and working environment.

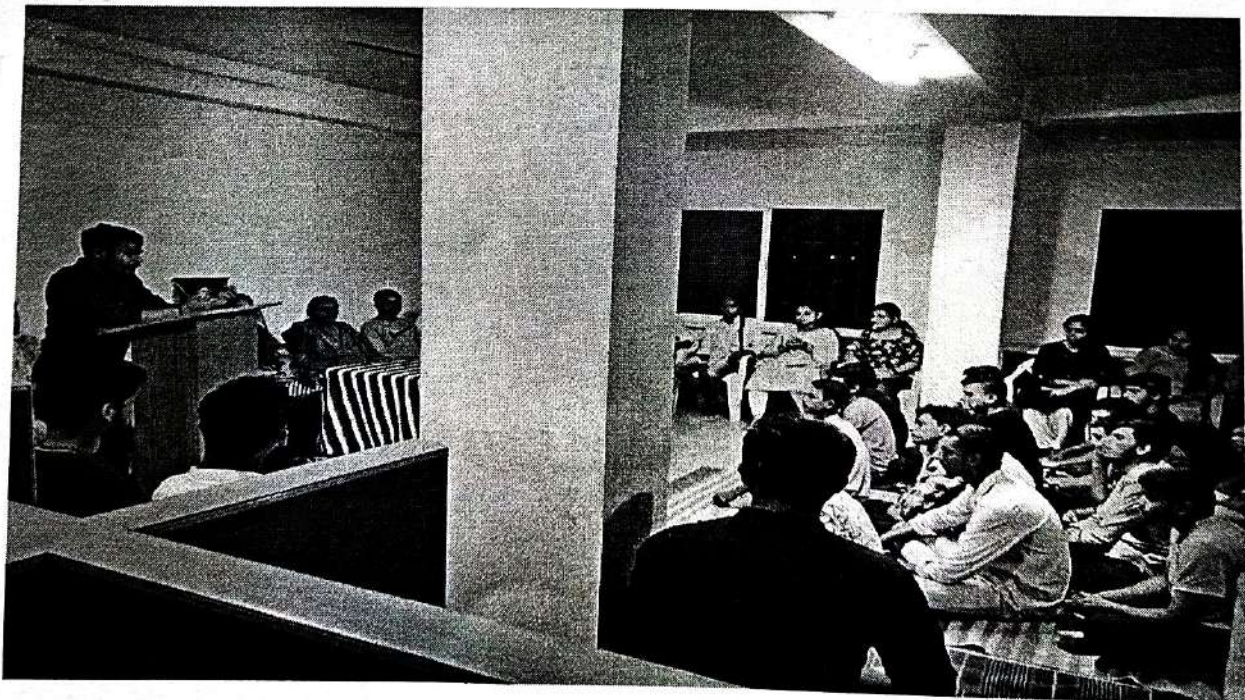
4. Summary :

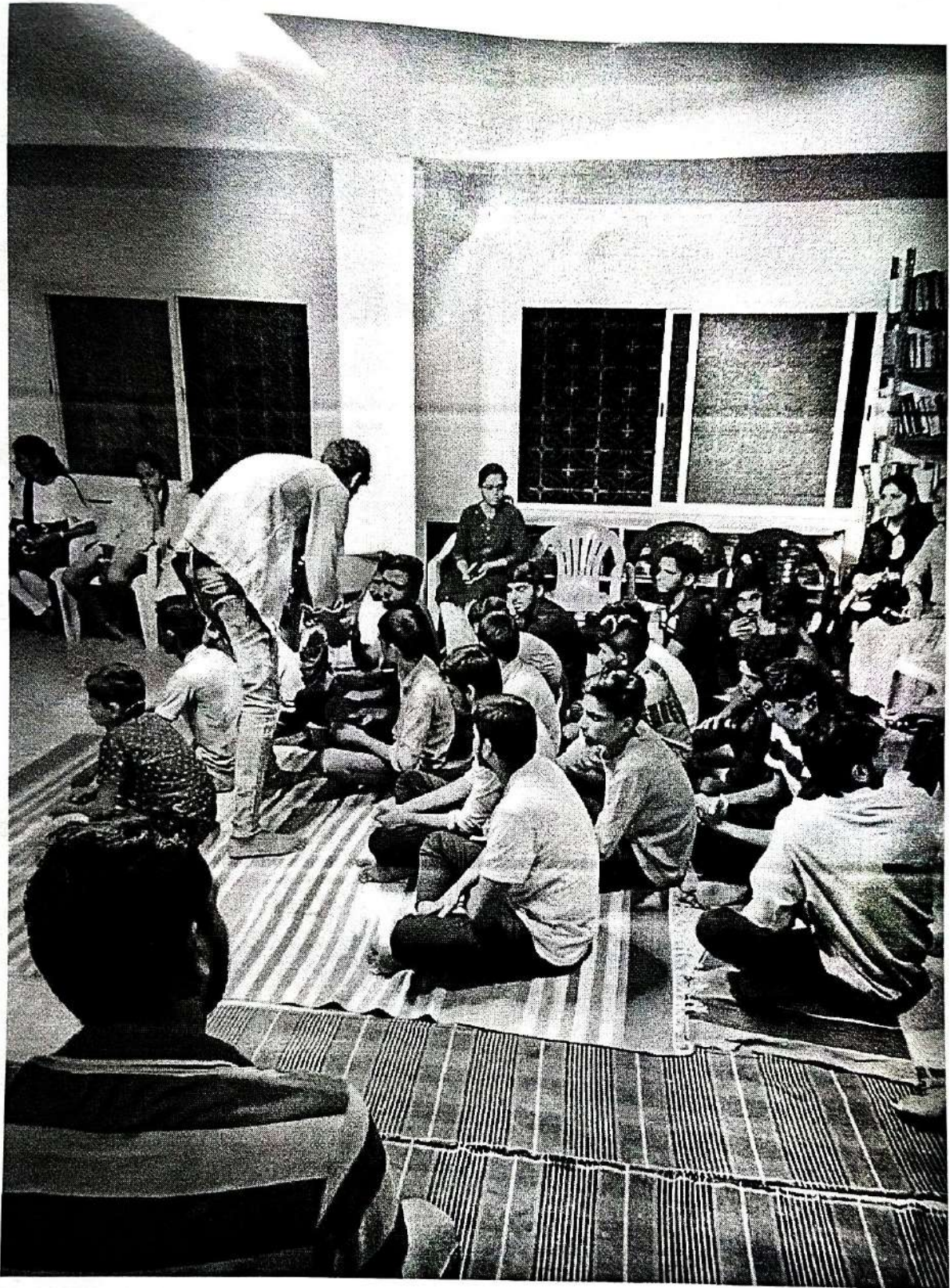
