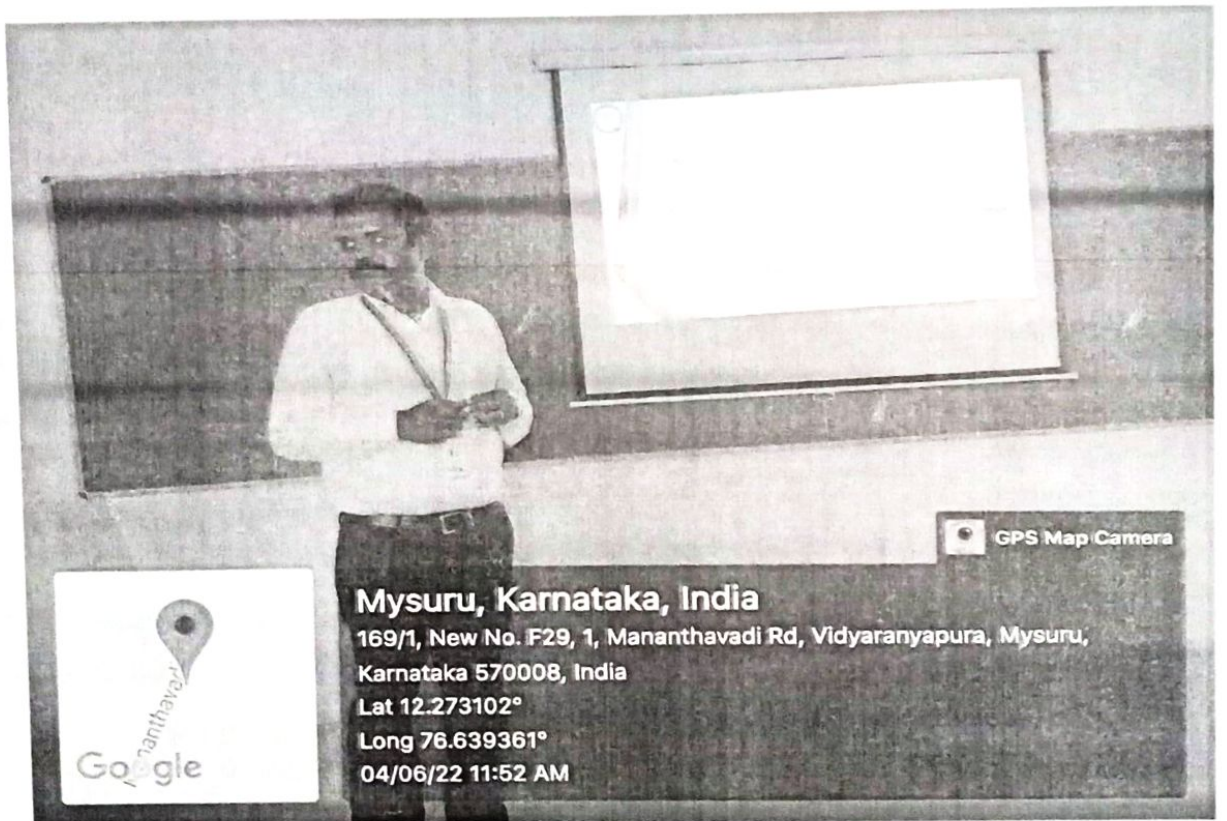
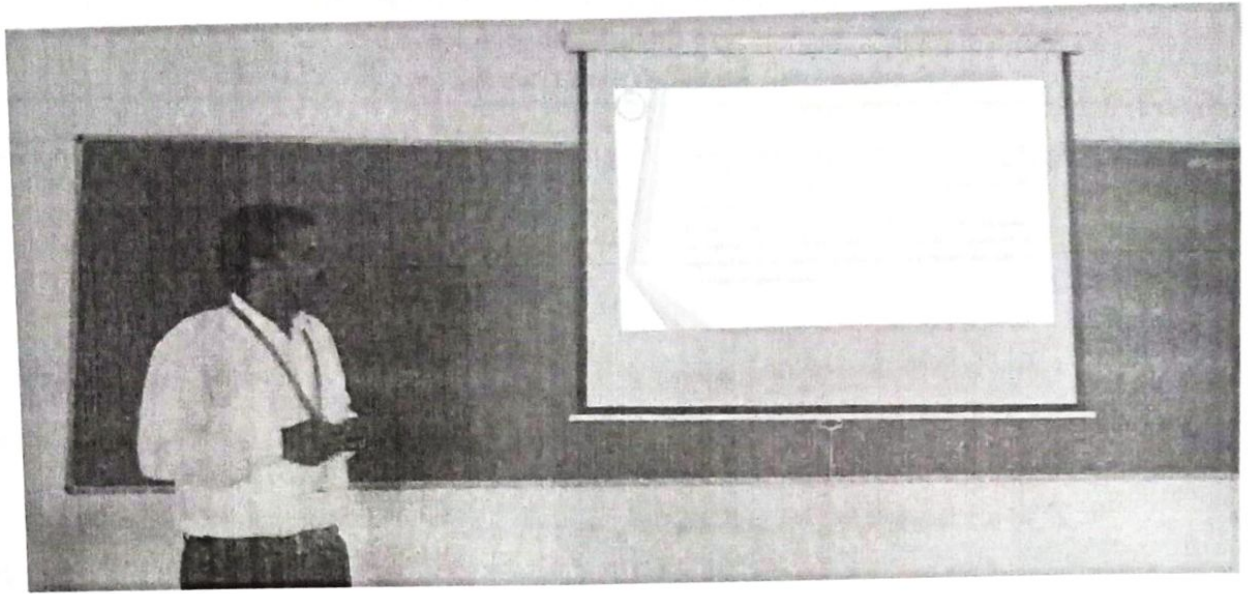

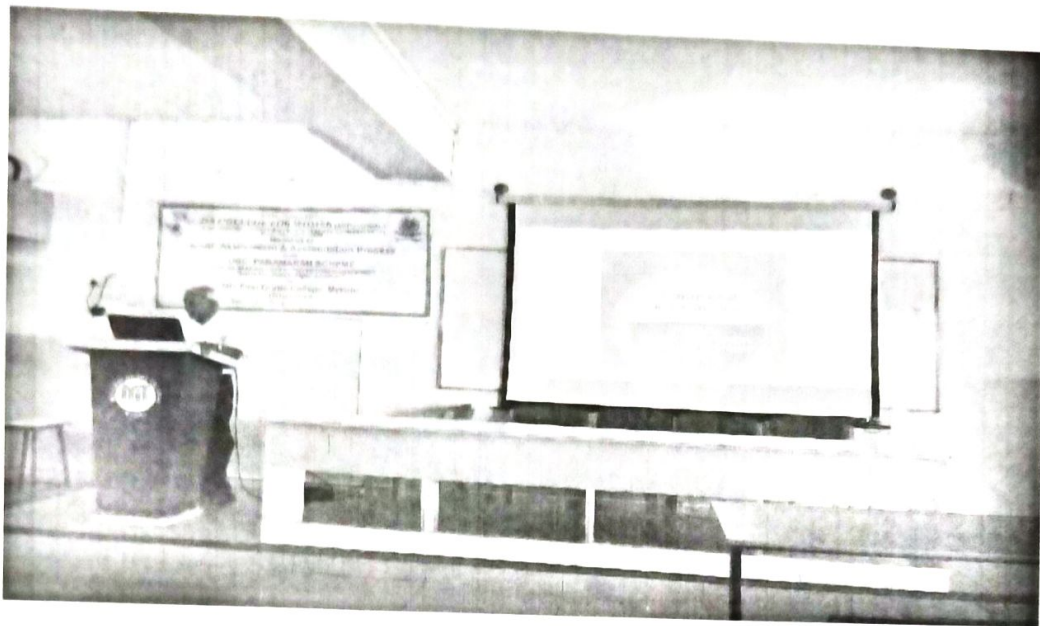

4. Summary

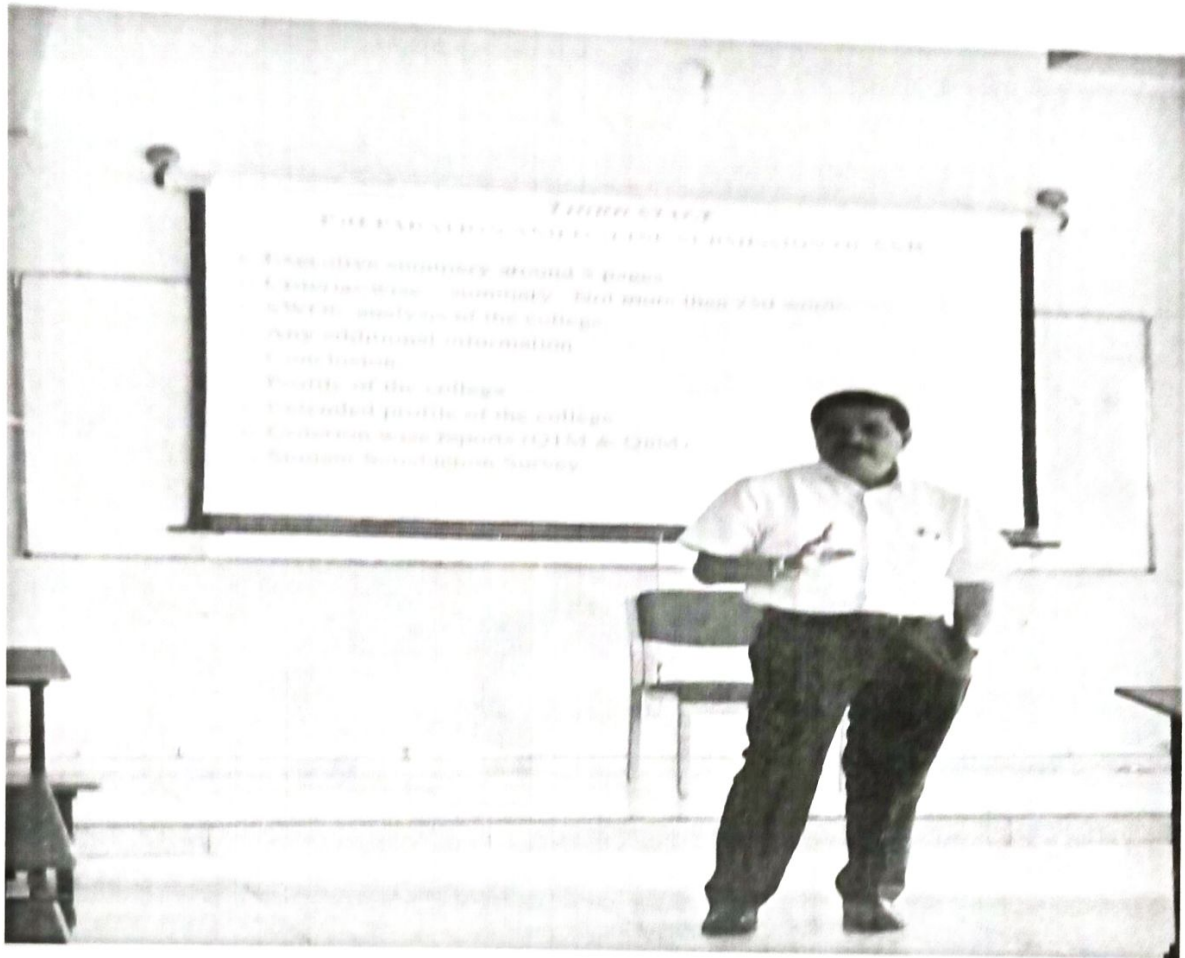

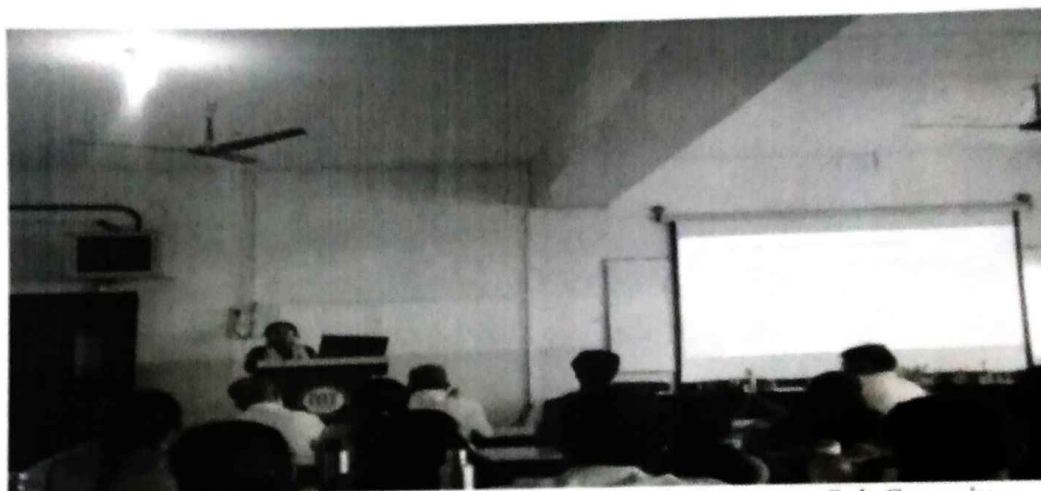
