





4. Summary




The First technical session was on **Highlights of NEP-2020** by **Dr. Padmavathi B S,** Director, CESS & Convener, Sub Committee - Task Force on Implementation of NEP in Karnataka, Bangalore. She highlighted on the new features of the NEP-2020 and its benefits to the academic fraternity and student's clientele. She focused on the multidisciplinary aspect of the NEP-2020 and its role in increasing gross enrollment ratio.

The second technical session was on Structural and regulatory reforms to adopt during the implementation phase of NEP-2020. The speaker of the session was **Mr. Gowrisha**, Deputy Director, CESS, Chief Consultant, and Committee for draft National Education Policy, Bangalore. He enlightened on the evolutionary stages of NEP from the period of Radha Krishnan committee, Kothari and till present NEP-2020. He emphasized on the modes of implementation of NEP through qualitative initiatives by the colleges.
