D) Feedback from Students on Teachers

Interpretation

The interpretation of the feedback data of II, IV and VI semester of the academic year 2022-23 has revealed that the faculty members have got positive feedback about their regularity to the class, prior preparation for class, subject knowledge, presentation and communication skills. The students are satisfied with the time allotted for interaction with the concerned subject teachers; students have good opinion on the evaluation process of internal assessment, and overall academic performance.

Action Taken

The feedback data of the year 2022-23 was analysed by the Academic Advisors Prof. T.T. Thomas and Dr. PandurangaVittal. The faculty members who have got below the expecting remark, were consulted by the advisory members and were advised that the faculty members to improvise their teaching skills and to introduce new technology to assist students to learn better.

Based on the analysis and interpretation of the feedback, the following actions have been taken for the improvement of the student community:

- Feedback on teachers has been taken twice a year to ensure that students are given importance.
- The teachers are advised to be more accessible to the students outside the classrooms and address their academic and non-academic issues.
- More academic related activities were organized
- Mentors were informed to conduct counseling sessions for the academically challenged students.

II) Feedback from Students on Institution and Infrastructure

III) Feedback from Faculty on Curriculum

Interpretation

Action Taken

Based on the analysis and interpretation of the feedback, the following actions are taken to improve the overall academic excellence of the institution:

- To improvise the library facilities by adding a greater number of books.

- Wi-Fi facility enhanced
- Seminars/Conferences/Workshops will be organized regularly.

IV) Feedback from Alumni on Academic, College, Administration and Infrastructure

Interpretation

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- The alumni said that the faculty members are always reachable for guidance and support.
 - The alumni are satisfied with the accessibility of the administrative staff.
 - The feedback analysis revealed that teaching, learning, and administration is satisfactory.
 - The overall feedback is very good and most of the alumni are satisfied with the institution.

Action Taken

Based on the analysis, interpretation, and suggestions given by the alumni, the decision is taken to increase the network of the alumni by registration and fund generation. The requirement for expansion of campus is brought to the notice of the management.

- Placement was the main issue in their comments and we solved it with by inviting more firms.

V) Feedback from Parents/ Guardian on college.

Interpretation:

The interpretation of feedback from the parents/guardian for the academic year 2022-23 has revealed that the college environment for their wards is contributing to their overall development. The following is the summary of feedback given by Parents/ guardian

- Parents are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities available in the college and have found it to be safe and secure for their wards.

Actions Taken:

VI) Feedback from Employers on alumni (students):

Interpretation:

The interpretation of feedback from the employers on alumni for the academic year 2022-23 has revealed that they are satisfied with the contribution made by the alumni of our institution. The following is the summary of feedback given by employers.

- The employers of the students/alumni of the college felt that general communication skills students of the institution is average.
- It is also expressed that; the students have insufficient knowledge on the upgraded versions of the technology and workplace equipment.
- The employers appreciated the team spirit and good values of the employees and their contribution towards organizational.
- An average opinion was given regarding leadership qualities, innovation, creativity and problem-solving ability of employees (Alumni/students).

Actions Taken:

- It was recommended to start skill development sessions, professional communication and personality development classes at regular intervals.
- Field visits and institution visits should be arranged to provide more practical exposure to the current students to meet the industrial requirements.
- It is also planned to start training programs to develop inter personal skills of the students.
